Original Lock Survey



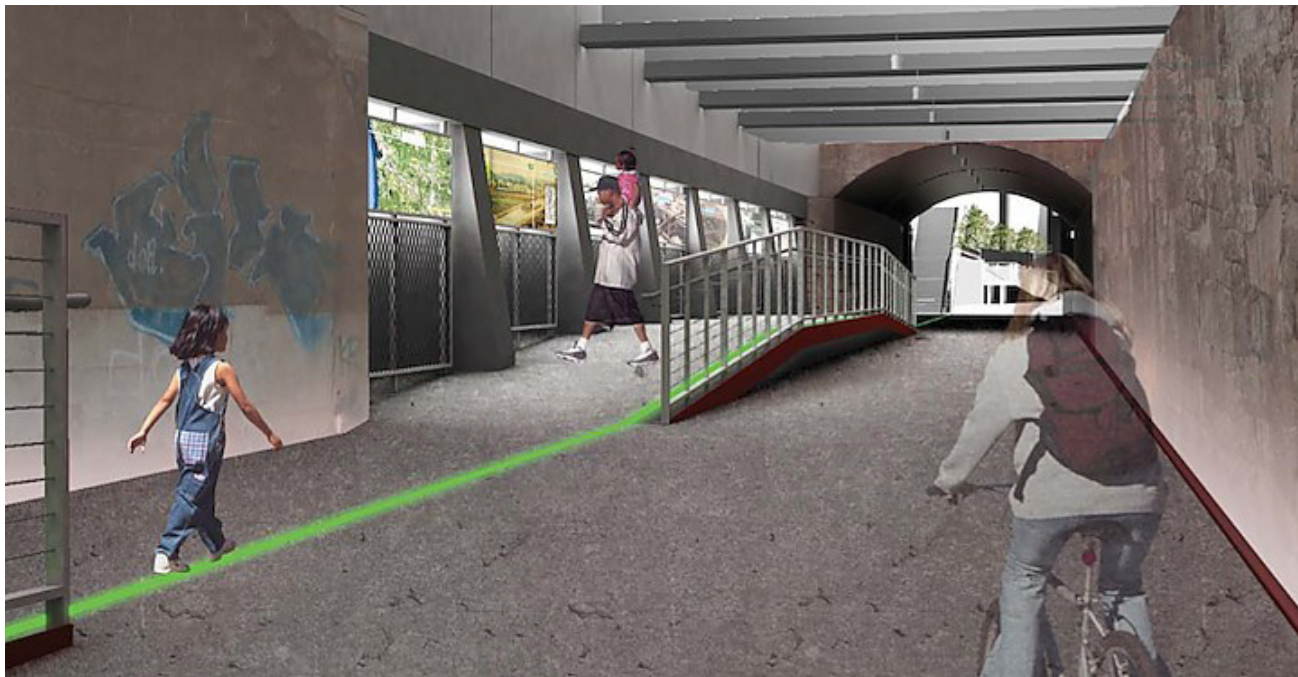
## Canal - Railroad - Trail



Current condition of adjacent Canal Trail

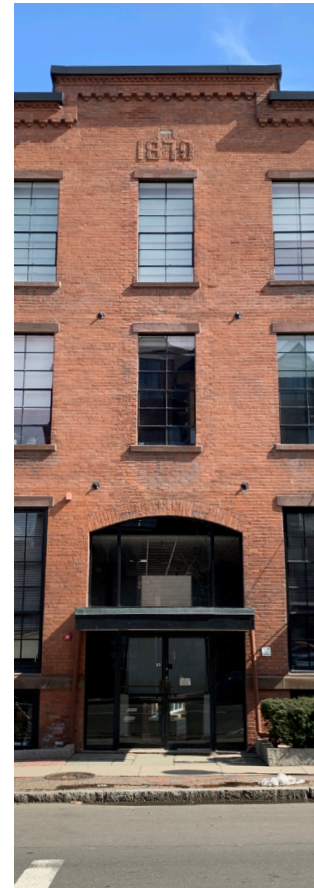
